MAP column in table below gives locations approximately marked on 2011 - 14 - 15 map, surveyed in sections A to H roughly defined by broken lines extending in line with walls of the church. MAP references in bold and underlined (circled on map) may be more accurate than those in plain typeface (uncircled on map). MAP references "X" in table mean graves reported to be present, but not yet found. In the blank areas of the map, we believe there are many more graves which are no longer visible in 2011 - 14 - 15. This (final) 2015 survey adds several graves made visible by Cardiff Council Bereavement Dept.'s excellent clearance of the graveyard overgrowth.

PREV column refers to previous surveys in 1982 and 1888.

-- "GF" numbers correspond to those given to Monumental Inscriptions quoted in full by Diane Brook and K.L.Chapman of the Glamorgan Family History Society (GF) and shown on their rough sketch of grave positions in April 1982, available from Glamorgan Archive Service.

-- "W" numbers correspond to the references "WAL.1" to "WAL.12" given at the end of the 1982 list to inscriptions quoted by David Jones of Wallington (W) in 1888, whose notebooks are stated to be in Cardiff Central Library. Locations of these 18th and 19th century graves are not known to us, hence their "X" references in table.

DESCRIPTN column describes appearance of grave, as found by 2011-14-15 surveys, or as listed in 1982 survey. **DETAILS** column includes information selected from the earlier surveys and that found by the 2011-14-15 surveys.

The present 2011-14-15 survey and map list all the graves mentioned in the 1982 survey, with some corrections of map positions, and includes graves listed in 1982 that were not visible in 2011. A number of graves are listed for the first time in the present survey. The Friends of St. Mary's would welcome comments, corrections and additions by email to founders@stmaryscaerau.org

Grateful thanks are conveyed to Oliver Davis, Paul Kemble, Ben Thomas, Delia Jay, Angela Frowen, and Cardiff Council Bereavement Dept. for participation in the surveys; and to James Frowen for his student thesis (available from Cardiff Library), which inspired us to begin these surveys, and to Dave Horton of Communities First, Nigel Billingham, Stephen K. Jones, and Maureen Clifford for providing information and documents.

For reference, an index of burials from 1725 to 1902 in St. Mary's Caerau and from 1724 to 1909 in St. Michael Michaelston-super-Ely can be bought from the Glamorgan Family History Society. That index and images of the original hand-written parish registers, can be consulted in the Glamorgan Archives at Sloper Road, Cardiff. There are many small (and a few large) discrepancies between dates given in that index and in the present surveys.
